


RECYCLING GUIDE FOR PAPERS



PREPARATION FOR RECYCLING

- Separate white papers and colored papers. Make sure papers are not laminated
- Remove papers with food and drink residues since those cannot be recycled
- Clean the papers by removing tapes, staple wires, stickers, plastics and any solid residues
- Dry the papers before stacking
- Flatten the papers to save space

RECYCLING GUIDE FOR SARTONS



PREPARATION FOR RECYCLING

- Empty the cartons of their contents, ensuring that they are completely free of liquids or food remnants.
- Dry the cartons before stacking
- Remove any non-paper components from the cartons, such as plastic spouts or caps.
- Flatten the cartons and stack neatly to save space during storage and transportation.
